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- 1. The valve should be installed with the center of the inlets no less than 2" inside the finished wall. Extensions are available if the valve is deeper.
- Connect the hot water supply to the side stamped HOT, and cold water to the side stamped COLD.
 Do not reverse these connections, or supply water to any other port.
- 3. Be sure hot water heater is connected, clean, and set to approximately 130°-140° Fahrenheit. If there is no hot water, the valve cannot be calibrated.
- 4. Remove the construction cover and flush the lines.
- 5. Install valve cartridge using the screws and O-rings from the construction cover. Check for flow and leaks.
- 6. Install threaded and square tubes.
- Rotate the Square Tube all the way to the right to obtain maximum cold water. Reverse (counter-clockwise) completely to obtain maximum hot water. Return again slowly to the right (clockwise) until the flowing water is 105°. This is the most common temperature for adult bathing.
- 8. Carefully install Cover Plate, Dial and black plastic Anchor.
- 9. Remove the Swivel Bushing from inside the Pointer by loosening set screws. Tighten the Swivel Bushing onto the Threaded Tube, taking care not to change position of Square Tube.
- 10. Install the Pointer facing 105° and tighten set screw. Add Cylinder Handle, lining up the pointers, then tighten set screws to secure.
